

CMRA Meeting Minutes for May 2015

The meeting was called to order by Daniel (KC0UTW) at 7 PM. There were 11 members and 1 guest in attendance.

Recording Secretary: The April minutes were approved as written.

Treasurers Report: Checking Account - \$761.40; CD - \$2290.38

Old Business:

Don (KM0R) reported on the trailer. Corey (KC0YNS) investigated the cost of insulation and plywood for the interior and for a counter. The insulation board (4ft x8ft x 1in) runs \$13.78 per sheet. It's estimated that we need 12 sheets for the trailer. The plywood (4ft x 8ft x5/8 in) runs \$17.67 per sheet. Counter top will run about \$100.00. Installation screws will also be needed. Rough estimate for materials is \$250.00. The committee recommended installing half of the insulation and plywood so that we can get a counter installed soon. There is a workday scheduled for 30 May at 9 AM at Mac's (K4CHS) house.

Mac (K4CHS) reported that the club has reserved a spot at Rock Bridge State Park for Field Day. Daniel (KC0UTW) asked if the club still has a banner or flag for use at Field Day. It appears that the flag is packed to go to Dayton with club members.
